1. Change pages iii-iv.
Governor Blanco has appointed new board members in Districts 1, 4, 6, and 7, and she has re-appointed a member in District 2.

The Table of Contents has been revised to reflect changes in Titles 37 and 40.

R.S. 37:1182.B.8 provides authority to the Board relative to the acquisition of immovable property.
4. Change pages 13-14.
R.S. 37:1212 changes the scope of practice for pharmacy technicians.
5. Change pages 17-20.
R.S. 37:1226.2 expands the sources of donations of previously dispensed medications to charitable pharmacies and provides limitation of liabilities to certain persons.
6. Change pages 25-58.
 - a. Three new definitions were added to R.S. 40:961.
 - b. Additional prohibitions on the possession of ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, and phenylpropanolamine were added to R.S. 40:962.1.1.A.
 - c. Technical name change relative to hydrocodone in Schedule III in R.S. 40:964.
 - d. Relative to penalties for convictions for possession of marijuana in R.S. 40:966.E.
 - e. R.S. 40:981.3.E.2 removes options for parole, probation, or suspension of sentence for convictions of CDS violations in drug-free zones.
 - f. R.S. 40:983.1 provides for penalties for convictions for creation or operation of clandestine laboratories within 1000 feet of school property.
