Re: Repeal of Certified Pharmacist Preceptor Program

During their August 15 meeting, the Board members voted to repeal the Certified Pharmacist Preceptor Program, as well as the requirement that pharmacy interns earn their hours of practical experience under the supervision of certified pharmacist preceptors. The Board voted to authorize the filing of an Emergency Rule to repeal those requirements, effective September 1, 2006.

Until further notice, any pharmacist with an active Louisiana license, whose license is not restricted or on probation with the Board, may supervise a pharmacy intern and sign their *Preceptor's Affidavit for Certifying Hours for Pharmacy Intern.*
