11 To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1007, relative to access to prescription monitoring information
12 and audit trail information.

13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

14 Section 1. R.S. 40:1007 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

15 §1007. Access to prescription monitoring information and audit trail information

16 * * *

17 G. The board may provide prescription monitoring information in response to
18 queries from prescription monitoring programs, electronic health information
19 systems and pharmacy information systems located in other states and federal
20 jurisdictions, through its participation in a secure interstate data exchange
21 system, and the information may be used by those programs in a manner
22 consistent with this Section.
