SENATE BILL NO. 212

PHARMACISTS. Provides relative to a specific date for the term of appointment of board members. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 37:1177(A), relative to the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy; to
3 provide for a specific date for the beginning of the term of pharmacists who are
4 appointed to the board; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 37:1177(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §1177. Terms

8 A. Except as provided in R.S. 37:1175, pharmacist members of the board
9 shall be appointed for a term of six years, **beginning on July 1 of the year in which**
10 **the appointment is made.**

11 * * *

12 Section 1. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
13 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
14 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
15 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
16 effective on the day following such approval.

DIGEST

Present law does not specify a date for the beginning of the term of a pharmacist appointed to the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy.

Proposed law specifies that the term of any pharmacist who is appointed to the board shall commence on July 1 of the year the appointment is made.

Effective upon the signature of the governor.
