Chapter 25. Prescriptions, Drugs, and Devices

§2521. Emergency Refills

- A. Using sound professional judgment, a pharmacist may refill adequate medication for a ~~seventy-two (72) hour regimen~~ quantity not to exceed a 30 day supply when an emergency for medication has been adequately demonstrated and the prescribing practitioner is not available. The 30-day supply limitation shall not apply to multiple-dose unit-of-use containers.
