Chapter 29. Prescription Monitoring Program

* * *

§2917. Authorized Direct Access Users of Prescription Monitoring Information

A. The following persons may access prescription monitoring information in the same or similar manner, and for the same or similar purposes, as those persons are authorized to access similar protected health information under federal and state law and regulation:

- 1. – 5. ...
- 6. A medical examiner or coroner, or a delegate thereof, for the purpose of investigating an individual’s death;
- 7. A licensed substance abuse addiction counselor providing services as part of a state-licensed substance abuse or addiction treatment program.
- 8. A probation or parole officer for the purpose of monitoring an offender’s compliance with participation in a drug diversion program or with other conditions of probation or parole related to monitored drugs.
- 9. An epidemiologist with the Louisiana Department of Health for the purpose of assisting the board in analyzing prescription monitoring information in order to conduct public health evaluations to support public policy and education pursuant to an agreement with the board.
