Re: COVID-19 Guidance Information – Renewal of Emergency Period

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Gov. Edwards issued [Proclamation No. 25 JBE 2020: Public Health Emergency – COVID-19](#) on March 11, 2020; it shall remain in effect through April 9, 2020 unless terminated sooner.

Gov. Edwards issued [Proclamation No. 41 JBE 2020: Extension of Emergency Provisions](#) on April 2, 2020; it shall remain in effect through April 30, 2020 unless terminated sooner. Therefore, all previously issued waivers and guidance relative to this public health emergency shall remain in effect through April 30, 2020.

Gov. Edwards issued [Proclamation No. 52 JBE 2020: Extension of Emergency Provisions](#) on April 30, 2020; it shall remain in effect through May 15, 2020 unless terminated sooner. Therefore, all previously issued waivers and guidance relative to this public health emergency shall remain in effect through May 15, 2020.

Gov. Edwards issued [Proclamation No. 58 JBE 2020: State of Emergency for COVID-19 / Phase 1 of Resilient Louisiana](#) on May 15, 2020; it shall remain in effect through June 5, 2020 unless terminated sooner. Therefore, all previously issued waivers and guidance relative to this public health emergency shall remain in effect through June 5, 2020.

Gov. Edwards issued [Proclamation No. 74 JBE 2020: State of Emergency for COVID-19 / Phase 2 of Resilient Louisiana](#) on June 5, 2020; it shall remain in effect through June 26, 2020 unless terminated sooner. Therefore, all previously issued waivers and guidance relative to this public health emergency shall remain in effect through June 26, 2020.

Gov. Edwards issued [Proclamation No. 83 JBE 2020: State of Emergency for COVID-19 Phase 2 of Resilient Louisiana](#) on June 25, 2020; it shall remain in effect through July 24, 2020 unless terminated sooner. Therefore, all previously issued waivers and
