

Title: COVID-19 Public Health Emergency:
Marijuana Pharmacies

Policy No. I.D.8

Issued: 03-17-2020
Ratified: 05-27-2020
Extended: 11-18-2020

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1. The Board office received requests from multiple marijuana pharmacies with patients requesting delivery of dispensed marijuana products due to stay-at-home orders and physical distancing requirements.
 2. The Board President took notice of a pending assignment at the Board's Regulation Revision Committee to develop a regulatory proposal to amend §2451.Q to allow marijuana pharmacies to deliver dispensed marijuana products to their patients.
 3. The Board President authorized a waiver of the provisions of §2451.Q to allow a marijuana pharmacy to deliver marijuana products they have dispensed to their own patients, using their own staff and not any third parties. The waiver permits the pharmacy to deliver such products to the patient's location, be it at home, hospital, or any other location.
 4. During their August 13, 2020 meeting, the members approved *Regulatory Proposal 2020-G ~ Delivery of Dispensed Marijuana Products*. During their subsequent meeting on November 17, 2020, the Occupational Licensing Review Commission authorized the initiation of *Regulatory Project 2020-11 ~ Labeling & Delivery of Marijuana Products*.
 5. During their November 18, 2020 meeting, the members voted to extend this interim policy until the earlier of (1) the conclusion of the public health emergency, or (2) the date of promulgation of the rule changes included in *Regulatory Project 2020-11 ~ Labeling & Delivery of Marijuana Products*.
