12	A.	A pharmacist shall be on duty at all times during regular open hours of the pharmacy. The owner of the	
13		pharmacy shall employ an appropriate number of professional, technical and clerical personnel	
14		commensurate with the nature and scope of the pharmacy practice. The owner of the pharmacy shall ensure	
15		there are a sufficient number of licensed personnel on site when the pharmacy is open to competently and	
16		safely perform patient care services and dispense prescriptions accurately.	
17	B.	A pharmacy shall be open for business a minimum of 10 hours per week, with said business hours posted at the	
18		building entrance in full public view from outside the premises. Pharmacies holding permits classified as	
19		correctional, hospital, institutional, or nuclear shall be exempt from this requirement. A pharmacist shall be on	
20		duty at all times when the pharmacy is open for business, subject to the provision for the temporary absence of	
21		a pharmacist in Section 1109 of this Part.	
22	C.	No person credentialed by the board <u>may</u> shall be required to engage in the practice of pharmacy for a period	
23		of time longer than six hours without a rest break.	
24	<u>D.</u>	The owner of the pharmacy shall develop plans, policies and procedures to ensure business continuity in the	
25		event of natural or other disasters or emergencies. Such plans, policies and procedures shall include provisions	
26		for continuity of patient care in the event the pharmacy is unable to open for business. The pharmacy shall	
27		provide access to such plans, policies and procedures when requested by the board.
