12	A.	A pharmacist shall be on duty at all times during regular open hours of the pharmacy. The owner of the
13		pharmacy shall employ an appropriate number of professional, technical and clerical personnel
14		commensurate with the nature and scope of the pharmacy practice. The owner of the pharmacy shall ensure
15		there are a sufficient number of licensed personnel on site when the pharmacy is open to competently and
16		safely perform patient care services and dispense prescriptions accurately.
17	B.	Minimum Hours of Operation; Business Hours Posted
18		1. A pharmacy shall be open for business a minimum of 10 hours per week. <u>A pharmacist shall be on</u>
19		duty at all times when the pharmacy is open for business, subject to the provision for the temporary
20		absence of a pharmacist in Section 1109 of this Part.
21		2. with said business hours posted at the building entrance in full public view from outside the premises.
22		The pharmacy shall post its hours of operation at the building entrance in full public view from outside
23		the premises. Pharmacies holding permits classified as correctional, hospital, institutional, or nuclear
24		shall be exempt from this posting requirement.
25	C.	No person credentialed by the board may shall be required to engage in the practice of pharmacy for a period
26		of time longer than six hours without a rest break.
27	<u>D.</u>	The owner of the pharmacy shall develop plans, policies and procedures to ensure business continuity in the
28		event of natural or other disasters or emergencies. Such plans, policies and procedures shall include provisions
29		for continuity of patient care in the event the pharmacy is unable to open for business. The pharmacy shall
30		provide access to such plans, policies and procedures when requested by the board.
