9	E. Temporary Closure of Pharmacy in an Emergency
10	1. When the Governor issues or renews a state of emergency pursuant to the Emergency Assistance and
11	Disaster Act of 1993, R.S. 29:721 et seq., or a state of public health emergency pursuant to the Louisiana Health
12	Emergency Powers Act, R.S. 29:760 et seq., or when the pharmacist-in-charge determines it necessary to close the
13	pharmacy for a temporary period of time during an emergency and/or Act of God, the following provisions shall
14	apply:
15	a. The pharmacy shall notify the board in written form with information as to the anticipated duration of the
16	temporary closure as well as the provisions for continuity of patient care no later than the next business day.
17	b. The pharmacy may establish a secure storage area separate from, but adjoining to, the secured
18	prescription department within which the pharmacy may store prescriptions prepared for delivery to the patient, or
19	his agent or caregiver. In the alternative, but only after receiving approval from the board, the pharmacy may
20	establish a temporary secure storage area separate from and not adjoining the prescription department within which
21	the pharmacy may store prescriptions prepared for delivery to the patient, or his agent or caregiver.
22	c. Access to prescriptions stored in the temporary secure storage area shall be restricted to individuals
23	designated by the pharmacist-in-charge.
24	d. Prepared prescriptions stored in a temporary secure storage area may be delivered to the patient, or his
25	agent or caregiver, whether or not a pharmacist is on duty, but only when so authorized by the pharmacist-in-charge.
