An official exempted from registration under 21 CFR §1301.23 shall include on all prescriptions issued by him his branch of service or agency and his service identification number, in lieu of the registration number of the practitioner required by this Section. Each such prescription shall have the name of the officer stamped, typed, or hand printed on it, as well as the signature of the officer.

4. A practitioner may prescribe, administer or provide directly any narcotic drug listed in schedule III, IV, or V approved by the FDA specifically for use in maintenance or detoxification treatment to a narcotic dependent person if the practitioner complies with the requirements of 21 CFR.
