6	§1141. Centralized Prescription Dispensing
7	A. General Requirements
8	1. An on-site pharmacy may obtain centralized prescription dispensing services from a remote dispenser
9	provided the pharmacies:
10	a. have the same owner or have entered into a written contract or agreement that outlines the services to be
11	provided and the responsibilities and accountabilities of each pharmacy in compliance with federal and state laws,
12	rules, and regulations; and
13	b. share a common electronic file or have appropriate technology to allow access to sufficient information
14	necessary or required to provide the requested services.
15	2. All drugs dispensed to a patient that have been dispensed by a remote dispenser shall bear a label containing
16	an identifiable code that provides a complete audit trail of the dispensing of the drug and pharmacy primary care
17	activities.
18	B. Policies and Procedures
19	1. On-site pharmacies and remote dispensers engaging in the acquisition or provision of centralized dispensing
20	services shall maintain a policy and procedure manual for reference by all personnel; it shall be made available for
21	inspection and copying by the board.
22	2. At a minimum, the manual shall include policies for:
23	a. a description of how the parties will comply with federal and state laws and regulations;
24	b. the maintenance of appropriate records to identify the responsible pharmacist(s) in the dispensing and
25	counseling processes;
26	c. the maintenance of a mechanism for tracking the prescription drug order during each step in the dispensing
27	process;
28	d. the maintenance of a mechanism to identify on the prescription label all pharmacies involved in the
29	dispensing the prescription drug order; and
30	e. the provision of adequate security to protect the confidentiality and integrity of patient information and to
31	prevent its illegal use or disclosure.
