| 6 | §1145. Remote Access to Prescription Drug Orders, Medical Orders, and Chart Orders |
| 7 | A. Notwithstanding any provision of rules to the contrary, nothing shall prohibit a Louisiana licensed pharmacist |
| 8 | who is an employee of or under contract with a pharmacy in Louisiana from accessing that pharmacy's dispensing |
| 9 | information system from a location other than the pharmacy in order to process prescription drug orders, medical |
| 10 | orders, or chart orders, but only when all of the following conditions are satisfied: |
| 11 | 1. the pharmacy establishes controls to protect the privacy and security of confidential records; |
| 12 | 2. the pharmacist does not engage in the receiving of written prescription drug orders or medical orders or chart |
| 13 | orders or the maintenance of such orders; and |
| 14 | 3. no part of the pharmacy's dispensing information system is duplicated, downloaded, or removed from the |
| 15 | pharmacy's dispensing information system. |
| 16 | A. Notwithstanding any rule to the contrary, a Louisiana-licensed pharmacist or pharmacy technician employed |
| 17 | by or contracted with a permitted pharmacy in Louisiana may remotely access that pharmacy's dispensing information |
| 18 | system from a non-pharmacy location for the purpose of processing prescription drug orders, medical orders, or chart |
| 19 | orders contained therein, provided all of the following conditions are met: |
| 20 | 1. Privacy and Security Controls. The pharmacy shall establish and maintain appropriate safeguards to protect |
| 21 | the privacy and security of all confidential records. |
| 22 | 2. Supervision of Remote Pharmacy Technicians. When a pharmacy technician remotely accesses the |
| 23 | dispensing information system, the pharmacy shall ensure that the supervising pharmacist: |
| 24 | a. provides direct and immediate supervision of the pharmacy technician through two-way audio and video |
| 25 | communication; |
| 26 | b. has immediate access to the original order and any related documentation; and |
| 27 | c. reviews and verifies the accuracy of all entered information. |
| 28 | 3. Data Protection. No part of the pharmacy's dispensing information system may be duplicated, downloaded, |
| 29 | or removed from the system at any time. |
| 30 | 4. Prohibition on Off-Site Record Handling. The receipt, retention, or storage of prescription drug orders, |
| 31 | medical orders, or chart orders at any remote location outside the permitted pharmacy is strictly prohibited. |
| 32 | 5. Policy and Procedure Manual. The pharmacy permit holder and the pharmacist-in-charge shall be responsible |
| 33 | for the development and implementation of policies and procedures to address quality assurance standards for remote |
| 34 | access and processing. |
