## MEMORANDUM

Re: Pharmacies Reporting Veterinary Prescriptions to the Louisiana PMP

The dispensing of a veterinary prescription and the subsequent reporting to the Louisiana PMP requires the *animal owner's information* (last name, first name, DOB, and gender), *animal name with species* (e.g. Brutus Canine), *and species code.* 

Pharmacy Management Systems differ on how that information should be entered by the pharmacist for prescription processing and subsequent PMP reporting. It is strongly recommended that you contact your system vendor for guidance.

The **ASAP 4.2** reporting fields required to properly report *veterinary prescriptions* to the Louisiana PMP are populated as follows:

Reporting as indicated above will list the pet's prescriptions under their owner's PMP patient report. An *animal icon* embedded beside the pet's prescription transactions will distinguish it from the owner's personal prescriptions. As a side note, the pet's prescriptions will not factor in to the owner's NarxCare Scores.
